Cecilia Noel Siqueira Franco of Uruguay and Franco de Lima of Brazil will captivate audiences with their technical virtuosity and daring arrangements for two guitars. In our concerts, the Duo will treat us to a diverse musical evening with selections of classics, traditional Spanish guitar, popular music, and Brazilian folk music, including choro.

The effortless mastery of violinist Rolf Haas will be featured in our February concerts. A musician of diverse interests and influences, he has often performed with visual artists and is also a respected hip hop artist (emcee and producer). He will be accompanied by Miki Aoki, an accomplished pianist and collaborative artist. The concert at The Current will display the duo's versatility as they perform lighter works and diverse range of styles. In the St. Paul's concert, Haas will showcase virtuosic violin works with Aoki accompanying him on the concert grand piano.

March will be an exciting month as we partner with Lyford Cay International School to bring you the artistry of the extraordinary Liam Teague. Dubbed "The Paganini of the Pan", Teague has an uncanny ability to convey the expressive and virtuosic capabilities of the steel pan.

Teague will present two unique programmes, each showcasing a different side of the steel pan. He will work his magic with the LCIS student steel pan ensemble who will open our concert at St Paul's. There, he will also perform solo, as well as classical works accompanied by Dr. Paul Jones on the piano. AYRIEL TRIO

The Aryiel String Trio was founded in 2016 with the goal of exploring the unique and fascinating sonorities of the violin, viola and cello in a chamber setting. All three artists are respected concert soloists in their own right. Ambra Albek, violin, is well known to Bahamian audiences having played for the Nassau Music Society and given several Master Classes since the early 2000's. The Trio will undoubtedly delight us with two exceptional evenings of music.

OUTREACH

WHAT IS A MASTERCLASS?

As part of our outreach mission, all of our featured artists offer free masterclasses to local students and music enthusiasts. Although time allows only three to four students to perform, audience members can gain knowledge and insider information by observing the artist at work. An outstanding masterclass participant will be featured at each of our concerts. Masterclasses will be held at 1:00 pm at The Current at Baha Mar on the Fridays prior to our concerts and are free for NMS members to observe.

SCHOLARSHIPS

As an important part of its mission, since its inception 50 years ago The Nassau Music Society has provided scholarships to young Bahamians to further their musical careers. Many well-known musicians have been able to study abroad in part because of assistance received from the NMS. Ten years ago the NMS partnered with then College of the Bahamas, now University of the Bahamas, to make an annual award to a deserving music student.

To date we are proud to have assisted a number of very promising Bahamian students. The music community will have benefited by \$80,000 when the scholarship programme is complete.

STUDENT ENRICHMENT

We are thrilled to announce the NMS-GSO Student Enrichment Programme which will afford 15 students from four participating schools the opportunity to attend world class music performances. Additionally, the students will receive lessons about the instrument, the pieces to be performed as well as concert etiquette to ensure a meaningful experience.
